## SUPPORTING ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT

- 40% of riders surveyed use fixed routes to access employment
- 60% of surveyed riders said they would not be able to work without Cecil Transit services
- Microtransit reduces time to gain employment by 22 days
- 2,500–3,000 new jobs are coming to Cecil County
