
TAM 5310 Grant Application Process Follow-Up Questions/Answers – September 18, 2020

1. Will applicants be able to submit the application via ProjectWise?

NO, you must upload the Part II, Part III, budget, vehicle order forms plus the supporting documents up to the MDOT MTA Grant Application Portal. You must register before uploading any documents. See application for portal information.

2. In past years, pagination was to follow the application document; is that true for this application process?

For the FY2022-FY2023 5310 Grant Application process, you may begin Part II and Part III pagination with page one (1).

3. What is Non-Traditional Capital?

Non-Traditional Capital is something other than what is listed as traditional capital items such as Radio equipment, computer equipment, software, etc.

4. Is Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) is permitted under capital funding?

Yes.

5. How much funding can an agency use for Preventive Maintenance (PM)?

It is recommended that an agency examines how much PM was used in the years prior and base your request on the actual information and future forecasts.

6. Can an agency request vinyl seat covers instead of cloth seats?

Yes, vinyl seat coverings are offered.

7. Can the vehicle floor plans be uploaded to the TAM website?

Yes, the floor plans that OLTS has have been submitted to TAM for uploading to the on the TAM/OLTS 5310 grant application page.
